Doug thanked the Kriewaldts for donating the filling station to our historic village and said that the plaque on the building is now in place. He also said that Rob Kriewaldt has generously offered to donate \$2000.00 toward the electricity and security system.

Prior to the meeting the FOSH board members met, and they recommended that electricity and limited security be put in the buildings at a cost of approximately \$5200. The historic street is not used for the 6 months of winter and it was recommended that we wait until spring for installation. A show of hands showed everyone was in favor.

Doug has purchased a used computer because the updates no longer worked on his computer. The Lola Historical Society will split the cost of the computer with us, so we will both contribute \$159.00 for the computer and updates.

The chili luncheon will be held February 24th.
